9. **Participating Teams** Men: 8 teams, Women: 8 teams
(The tournament will not be held if fewer than 6 teams enter)

10 Eligibility

- Priority will be given to teams that have already registered for the WCT. If you are unsure how to register, please contact us in advance and WCT-JAPAN will assist with the registration process.
- If there are more than eight entries, the MCC Selection Committee will select the participating teams.
- If there are entries from overseas, the Selection Committee will select a maximum of two teams.
- MCC-registered teams (maximum 1-2 teams): Teams that meet the criteria set by the Selection Committee.
- If there are a large number of applications, the Selection Committee will make its decision by 24 May for men and 21 June for women, and notify the representatives of each team. (First deadline: Men: 10 May, Women: 7 June)
- If fewer than eight teams are selected, the entry of the teams that have applied will be confirmed, and additional entries will be accepted until one week before the tournament.

11 **Player Registration** Up to 5 players and 1 coach

12 **Competition Rules** In accordance with WCF The Rules of Curling and Rules of Competition, July 2025 (Japan Curling Association Competition Rules, September 2025 edition).

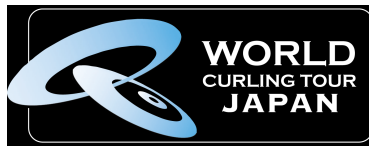
13 Competition Format

[Preliminary Round] Round-robin format

- Timer running continuously
- The match ends after 8 ends or at the end of the end at the 110-minute mark
- If the match is tied at the end of the 8th end or the end at the 110-minute mark, the winner will be decided by a draw shot taken by the team captain
- The top two teams from each league advance to the knockout stage

【Final】 Knockout format





- The timer runs continuously
- The match ends after 8 ends or at the end of the 110th minute
- In the semi-finals and third-place play-off, if the match is tied at the end of the 8th end or after 110 minutes, the winner will be decided by a draw shot taken by a representative
- An extra end will be played for the final only, limited to one end. If the match is still tied after this, the winner will be decided by a draw shot taken by the team captain

*If there are 6 participating teams

- The timer will run continuously
- Rankings will be determined by a round-robin format. (No knockout stage will be held)
- The tournament ends after 8 ends or at the end of the 110th minute
- If the match is tied at the end of the 8th end or after 110 minutes, the winner will be decided by a draw shot taken by the skip

*The reception for each division will be held on the evening of the first day of the tournament (Toya Main Store and Annex)

16 P r i z e M o n e y : Total of 600,000 yen for men and women

17 P o i n t s WCT points will be awarded based on ranking only if the tournament is held with 8 teams.

WCF points will also be awarded to participating players.

A tournament organised by the Victoria Curling Club (VCC), based in Victoria, Canada.

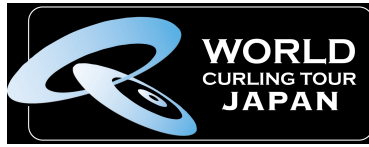
MCC and VCC entered into a partnership agreement in March 2026.
